Food-Ag Education Application & Guidelines

The Port Townsend Farmers Market is hosting a dedicated Food and Ag Education Booth every market week located near other growers on a rotating basis to different visiting organizations.

The market provides the canopy, table and chairs. We'll also submit a press release for the Events section of the paper and post the booth activity for that week on the Events page of our website with a link to the visiting organization(s) website(s), if available.

The visiting organization(s) provides the knowledge and interactive education activities and materials just one Saturday during the season – or more, if they'd like – for the full market day from 9:30 am – 1:30 pm. The Market asks the visiting group to also spread the word about their Day at the Market to their contacts.

This booth is intended to host activities and educational material that deepens shopper's awareness of the economic, environmental, health, social and many other benefits of supporting our local food system. Groups are to address issues related to local agriculture. For example, what are the barriers to farmers in our area – land, water, seed, capital and more?

Some ideas include:

- Planting pumpkin seeds with kids to harvest in time for market's Pumpkin Festival in Oct. (educating on planting & harvest timing)
- Seed swap at the market (& sharing info on seed preservation issues)
- Taste tests with nutritional value information comparing well-traveled foods to local foods
- Economic multiplier effect – What's the economic impact when I spend \$1.00 on local food vs. non-local? Drop a dollar in the bucket and see what happens.
- And many more creative ideas!

This space is not to be used for distributing political or religious information.

Fundraising will be allowed by donations only, unless authorized by the Market Manager. In addition, only limited and non-competing items, pre-approved by the Market Manager, may be used for fundraising. Non-profits wishing to fundraise must pay 4% of total sales and become a member of the market.

This space will be available on a rotating basis and must be scheduled with the Market Manager. Organizations using the space for more than three markets per season are asked to become member of market for \$30.
